SPEAKER USER MANUAL

This manual is intuitive as our software, is enough to observe the images to understand as to use best of and the more efficient form. The screens follow the logical order of the presentation them tools in the interface of each software.

It is the first audiobooks and podcasts player for Palm, produced in Brazil. Now in English.

Produced to play audiobooks and podcasts in an intuitive way with high sound quality, in MP3 and WAV, without conversions, direct of the card of memory. With resources of playing, to pause, to stop, to play previous, to play subsequent, to play the list indefinitely, to exclude and to increase. He still possesses controls: Volume and Equalizer, besides supplying detailed information of each audio file as: I Title, Author, Year, Bitrate, Channel and other infos. **And more: Speaker plays in background, or be you it can use other programs, to play, while he hears or simply to leave him playing. Hear anywhere atn any moment audiobooks and podcasts.** Only for colored palm. In english.

1.0 - For all models with Palm System 5.0 and with card reader (ram 302 KB)

Important: It works only on palms with card slot and stereo (stereo or mono).

Install

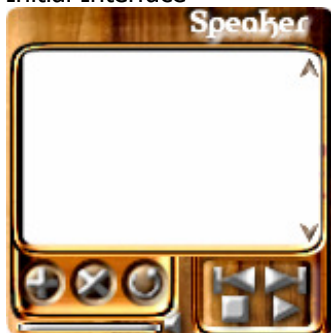
Just unpacking the zip on the desktop and give a double click the file **Speaker_eng.prc** the tool installation of your Palm will open showing the file being synchronized, synchronize and ready.

Also install the plugin sMP3pn.pdb that accompanies the program.



You recognize by the icon on the side.

Initial Interface



Here you have to interface with the controls and the list of MP3 files is audiobook or podcast.

INSTALLATION OF AUDIO FILES

Just drag it to the installer for Palm, MP3 and WAV files to the area of the card that is at the bottom of the installer. Synchronize and wait for the synchronization process is complete (depending on the volume of files can take half an hour).

Recommendation: Use only MP3 files because it has a compression rate that makes the files smaller ex.: Mp3 file 3 megs equivalent on average to a wav file of 30 megs.



Clicking on the above screen appears you will then select all the files visible in the list, or click one by one by selecting only those who want to be seen in the list to play. After selecting just click the button adds. The list will appear in the Speaker's initial interface screen as shown below:

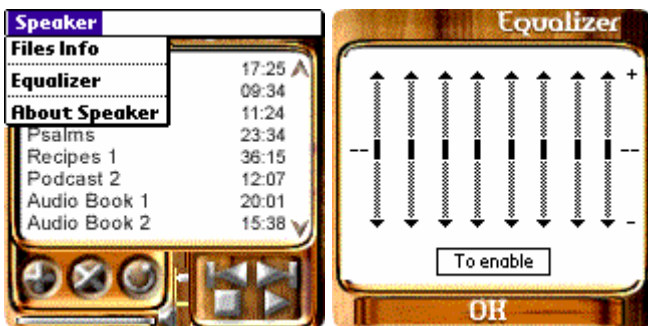


With the list assembled, simply adjust the volume icon by clicking once on the speaker, the bar will appear with the slider down the volume decreases, up increases.

For excluding its list, a file simply click on it once and then click the button. To play the file list indefinitely, simply click the button once.



These buttons are respectively from left to right, play the previous file, stop playing (which can be replaced by the pause button for a touch back and playing well with one touch), the last button to the right is to play the following.



To access the other controls Balance and Equalizer simply click on the top screen for the pull-down menu appears, choose the control you want to adjust. We recommend that before making adjustments of a first listen to audiobooks then yes make the adjustments. In the case of the equalizer it can generate distortions, more common in palm sleepy mono models like the Tungsten C.



By choosing the option to view the file infos you will have access to file details such as Title, Author, Year, Name, Folder, Duration, Bitrate, Channels, and other information.



By choosing About the Speaker will have access to basic help from the Speaker icon (i) at the top right of the screen.

Important:

Do not synchronize with the speaker paused. Unplug it and leave it or leave it playing while you synchronize.

He plays in the background even with the sync in progress.
